Internet Safety and your Child

In a world where technology and the internet has become such an important part of our lives, it is very important to monitor how our children are making use of these devices. Overall, it can be positive in the sense that they can access a plethora of information. However, there is also a great deal of information we do not want them to find. The world is a scary place, and the internet can offer a gateway to that world. In celebration of Safe Internet Day at CityKidz, here is some information on how you can protect your children.

When your children are on the web, ensure that they never send anyone their name, password, address, the name of their school or any information about their family to anyone. This could result in your child receiving some unwanted attention. This also means avoid

talking to strangers online and not agreeing to meet anyone in person.

However, how can our children meet strangers on the web? Social media is a way to meet people with similar interests to you. Social media sites such as Facebook and Twitter allow anyone to make connections despite physical distance. In order to have some control over who our children meet, adjust **your child's privacy** settings and monitor their activity on social media. There is nothing wrong with ensuring that your child is safe despite their claim that you are invading their privacy.

Another important thing to ensure your **child's safety is to control** what your child posts on his or her social media. Even something as innocent as a photo or selfie can be used for ill gain. Also, if you are uncomfortable



with any sights they are visiting or anyone they are talking to, take action and prevent your child from visiting these sites or talking to those people. For example, there is free software that can be used to protect your child from inappropriate or adult content such as Qustodio, which offers a comprehensive suite of tools to keep your kids safe online including content-filtering and time limits.

So, the key is to closely monitor what your child is doing. With a little bit of help, your children will be well on their way to becoming safe and ethical internet users.
