Learners must start working hard right from the onset as exams are just around the corner. Learners need to take responsibility for their work (or lack thereof). We have learners attending detention for homework and class work not done. If you are the parent of such a child, the detention is not enough. You need to take additional, punitive steps against

These final exams do carry a specific weighting, as per the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS). Parents and pupils need to be aware of the implications of this weighting, as a poor performance in these exams can easily prove to be quite devastating.

Please ensure your child prepares for these important exams over the next few weeks. Learners are expected to allocate sufficient study time in order to prepare thoroughly for each subject. Each child will receive a learning/study programme, sometime this week, with guidelines on what to actually study for each subject. Please see they adhere to these guidelines and prepare adequately. CAPS requires these exams to count 25% towards your child's final promotion mark in Grades 4 - 6 and as much as 60% in Grade 7. This weighting can make a huge difference if your child is unprepared and does not perform to their potential in their exams. The department is also enforcing the Progression Criteria so your child will need to get the marks in order to progress to the next Grade.


