The Art of Education at CityKidz for Grade 6 learners

I reached out and asked the Grade 6 learners what they learned in art class and how it continues to impact their lives. It was exciting to reconnect and dive deeper into why art education is such an important discipline. We all know that art is fun for children, but the arts as a discipline also helps with fundamental development. This can be seen in the creative process because art is all about creativity and it allows children to express themselves. As parents you might say that mathematics and science are important, of which they are, but visual arts pushes a child's creativity and divergent thinking skills to the next level. If children practice thinking creatively, it will come naturally to them now and in their future careers. Again, art does not just develop a child's creativity it develops certain skills such as focus, problem-solving and non-verbal communication, to name a few. These skills they learn often spill over into their academic achievements. Therefore, if you see your child drawing and colouring in do not be disheartened, let them complete their pictures or whatever they are making or doing.

At grade six level, art certainly builds a child's confidence whether it is performing, visual, or dramatic and theatre arts. There is something special about participating in the arts and learners use materials that they turn into visual stories. This is not only magical to experience as a teacher, but it also helps learners feel more confident as they improve their standard of work and see their own progress as they go. Also, it boosts their self-confidence as well as their self-esteem. An interesting point of view is that art education teaches learners how to interpret, criticize, and use visual information. As well as how to make choices based on that information. The arts can be challenging which is why it is called 'artwork' for a reason! Learners never quit or bunk art lessons, they always look forward to art class and they rise to occasion by doing their work.
