Dear Parent/Guardians

Children are very excited to go on the outings and learn outside the classroom. Read signs in the shops, road signs, advertisements, flyers, labels on food and household items. This will build your child's sight vocabulary. Sing songs and rhymes. This builds auditory memory which is important when spelling, writing and reading.

Praise your child often. This builds confidence and encourages your child to attempt new learning without fear of failure.

We welcome new families to CityKidz. We look forward to working with you. To our current families, I know you will continue to work with us, so your child can grow in confidence, with a love of learning, and a determination to be the best person they can be.

As parents and carers you need to emphasise the value of manners, kindness, school and education. Explain to your child that treating everyone with respect, saying "Please" and Thank You" are still the magic words. Being on time for school everyday, wearing the correct uniform and working hard is important to you. The value you place on these life skills will be the value your child holds. Pesach (Passover) 2022



Passover 2022 begins at sundown on Friday, April 15, and ends Saturday evening, April 23. The first Passover seder is on the evening of April 15 after nightfall, and the second Passover seder takes place on the evening of April 16 after nightfall. Passover is a festival of freedom. It commemorates the Israelites' Exodus from Egypt, and their transition from slavery to freedom.

On Passover, Jews may not own or consume chametz, anything containing grain that has risen. This includes virtually all breads, pastas, cakes and cookies. Prior to the holiday, homes are thoroughly cleaned for Passover, kitchens are purged, and the remaining chametz is burned or sold.

Following the intermediate days, when work restrictions are somewhat relaxed but chametz remains forbidden, they celebrate the final two days of Passover (just one day in Israel), during which they look forward to the future redemption through Moshiach (Messiah).

Passover is important to Jews, as it celebrates their birth as a nation.

We wish all our Jewish family and friends peace and prosperity and all the joys of Passover.

Easter

Easter Sunday is on April 17 in 2022. Good Friday is observed on April 15, and Easter Monday on April 18. Easter is a Christian festival that commemorates the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, described in the New Testament as having happened on the 3rd day of Jesus' burial following his crucifixion by the Romans at Calvary. It is the climax of Jesus's passion, preceded by Lent, 40 days of fasting, penance, and prayer. Many Christians around the globe refer to the week before Easter as the Holy Week. The customs of Easter vary among the Christians and include midnight vigils, sunrise services, exchanges of Paschal greetings, going to the church, decorations, and the breaking of Easter eggs.

Many of you may not know that we are fortunate to have the services in our neighbourhood of the Urban Rangers and CPF's ,from Urban Space Management ,as part of the City South Precinct operations.

Urban Rangers are always busy cleaning, removing illegal dumping and weeding while the Community Police Forum members are patrolling and supporting the Urban Rangers when they need assistance.

During a typical school day Goud and School Street is always jam-packed with students, school vehicles taxis and busses which often causes congestion in our area. After the students enter into their schools the area becomes relatively quiet until the hub-hub starts again from 13h30 to 16h00.

The team of heroes are doing their level best to drive out vagrants and illegal traders in the precinct. The matter of illegal traders has been reported to Joburg Metro Police Department and they are still waiting for their feedback.

Urban Rangers has finished to slash off the grass at corner School Street and Heidelberg Street and continue to always help maintain keeping our environment clean.

On the 18 of February 2022, there was an operation which took place along End Street between Albert and Durban Streets. They demolished illegal shacks and PIKITUP staff cleaned up the area.


